### Report Summary:

Crime data and monthly departmental activity is summarized with a historical perspective. Numbers are based on actual reports taken by the Frisco Police Department and have not been certified with Texas Department of Public Safety for the year.

### Comparative Data:

The Uniform Crime Index number for September 2016 in Frisco showed a 14.8% percent crime incident decrease from the month of August 2016. There is an overall UCR incident increase of 0.3% when comparing year to date September 2015 to September 2016

### Report Analysis:

There were 79 reported Assaults in September compared to 65 in August. Of the 79 reported assaults, 9 were Aggravated Assaults while the other 70 were reported as Simple Assaults. There has been a 6.2% increase in the number of reported assaults comparing year to date September 2015 to September 2016.

There were 27 Burglaries reported in September compared to 41 in August. Of the 27 reported burglaries, 13 were burglary of habitations while the other remaining 14 burglaries were burglaries of buildings (non-residential). Comparing year to date, burglaries are down 15.8% year to date from September 2015 to September 2016.

There were a total of 32 Burglary of Motor Vehicle (BMV's) reported in September compared to 42 reported in August. For method of entry in the 32 September BMV's the unlocked or unknown entry vehicles made up 58% of the reports. The forced or attempted entry made up the other 42% BMV reports. Vehicle burglaries are down 9.5% comparing year to date September 2015 to September 2016.

The police department responded to 175 motor vehicle accidents in September with a total of 1,428 motor vehicle accidents in 2016. Accidents are up 24.7% comparing year to date September 2015 to September 2016.
