Subject: Consider and act upon adoption of a Resolution accepting the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Sub-Recipient Grant Award No. 2982102 from the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) and authorizing the City Manager to execute the Sub-Recipient Grant Agreement by and between the City of Frisco and the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD).

Action Requested: City Council consideration and approval of a Resolution accepting the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 UASI Sub-Recipient Grant Award No. 2982102, in the amount of \$95,450, from the USDHS and authorizing the City Manager to execute a Sub-Recipient Grant Agreement by and between the City of Frisco and the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD).

Background Information: City Council approved Resolution No. 16-02-08R at their February 2, 2016 Meeting, authorizing the City Manager to submit four (4) applications for funding under the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 UASI Grant Program. Three (3) applications were applicable to the Frisco Fire Department and one (1) was applicable to the Frisco Police Department. The City successfully submitted the applications and the Fire Department was notified on October 4, 2016 of the award of \$95,450 under the FY 2016-2017 UASI Grant Program. A summary of the grant award is below:

UASI Grant Award – Frisco Fire Department

- Sub-Recipient Grant Award No. 2982102, Hazmat Enhancement. The Grant Application requested funding to replace the Smith Detection Hazardous Materials (HazMat) ID and HazMat Responder with a one (1) new unit and a 3-year service agreement. The proposed cost for this request includes utilizing a \$10,000 trade-in credit for the current equipment. The estimated cost for this is \$95,450.

Alternatives: City Council could consider the following alternatives:

- Approval of the Resolution;
- Input towards the discussion as desired;
- Deny approval of the Resolution and send back to staff with direction.

Financial Considerations: The total amount of funding issued under Sub-Recipient Grant Award No. 2982102 is \$95,450. The UASI Grant Program does not include a matching funds requirement for the City.

Legal Review: The City Attorney has reviewed and approved the Grantee Conditions and Responsibilities Agreement as to form.
