Subject: Consider and Act Upon Approval of Purchase Orders to Paradigm Traffic Systems, Inc., for the Purchase of Traffic Signal Equipment and Video Detection Systems during FY 2017

Action Requested: City Council approval of purchase orders to Paradigm Traffic Systems, Inc., for the purchase of traffic signal equipment and video detection systems during FY 2017 in the estimated amount of \$416,000.

Background Information: Purchase of traffic signal equipment and video detections systems made through an interlocal agreement with BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative, BuyBoard contract #432-13, and City of Frisco bid #1202-039. This item includes various purchases as needed for FY 2017, including; Video detection equipment, detection system cable, battery back-up systems, signal hardware, school zone flashers and gel cell batteries. Total estimated expenditure for FY 2017 is \$416,000.
