Re: Monthly Report – Oct 2016

Report Summary: Crime data and monthly departmental activity is summarized with a historical perspective. Numbers are based on actual reports taken by the Frisco Police Department and have not been certified with Texas Department of Public Safety for the year.

Comparative Data: The Uniform Crime Index number for October 2016 in Frisco showed there was no increase or decrease from the month of September 2016. There were 259 UCR reported incidents in September and October of 2016. UCR incidents are down .5% comparing year to date 2015 to 2016.

Report Analysis: There were 67 reported Assaults in October compared to 79 in September. Of the 67 reported assaults, 8 were Aggravated Assaults while the other 59 were reported as Simple Assaults. In 2016 there has been a total of 601 reported assaults, 73 or 12% were aggravated assaults with the remaining 528 or 88% reported as simple assaults. Year to date, all assaults are up 4.9% comparing 2015 to 2016.

One robbery was reported in October 2016. Year to date 2016 there have been 22 reported robberies compared to 26 reported robberies year to date 2015. Of the 22 reported robberies, 14 incidents were robberies of individual with 8 business robberies.

There were 26 Burglaries reported in October 2016 compared to 27 reported in September 2016. Of the 26 reported burglaries, 10 were burglary of habitations with 16 burglaries of buildings (non-residential). Year to date, burglaries are down 14.5% comparing 2015 to 2016.

There were 49 Burglary of Motor Vehicle (BMV's) reported in October 2016 compared to 32 reported in September 2016. For method of entry in the 49 October BMV's the unlocked or unknown entry vehicles made up 49% of the reports. The forced or attempted entry made up the other 51% BMV reports. Year to date, BMV's are down 6.3% comparing 2015 to 2016.
