Subject: Consider and act upon authorizing the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement by and between the City of Frisco and Cobb, Fendley & Associates, Inc. for design and preparation of construction documents for Town & Country Boulevard (Spring Creek to Legacy)

Action Requested: City Council consideration and approval of authorizing the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement by and between the City of Frisco and Cobb, Fendley & Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$449,799.00 for design and preparation of construction documents for Town & Country Boulevard (Spring Creek to Legacy).

Background Information: Under the Professional Services Agreement, Cobb, Fendley & Associates, Inc. design will prepare construction documents to reconstruct the existing pavement and add two eastbound lanes to Town and Country Boulevard from approximately 0.3 mile west of Legacy Drive to Spring Creek Parkway. The condition of the pavement in this segment is fair to poor. This pavement shows signs of settlement, cracking and previous repairs. Additional design includes storm sewer, water and sanitary sewer design. The cost of the services totals \$449,799.00.

Alternatives: City Council could consider the following alternatives:

- Authorize the City Manager to execute the Agreement;
- § Deny approval.

Financial Considerations: The contract will be funded with General Obligation Bonds and from Certificates of Obligation.

Legal Review: The Professional Services Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney as to form and legality.
