

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRISCO, TEXAS APPROVING THE AMENDED CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN, A SECTION OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT CONSOLIDATED PLAN, 2015 – 2019, AS REQUIRED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Subtitle A, Part 91 requires the City, as an entitlement community, draft and submit a Consolidated Plan including a Fair Housing Plan not less than every five years and requires citizen participation according to a Citizen Participation Plan (CPP); and

WHEREAS, the Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has established a new regulatory requirement for all entitlement communities related to "Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing" as required by the 1968 Fair Housing Act; and

WHEREAS, as an entitlement community, the City of Frisco is now required to prepare an "Assessment of Fair Housing" (AFH) and submit it to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) providing fair housing data, an assessment of fair housing issues, and identification of fair housing priorities and goals for the implementation and use of the City's HUD funding; and

WHEREAS, entitlement communities must amend their Consolidated Plans to include the new requirements of citizen engagement as it relates to the Assessment of Fair Housing in their Citizen Participation Plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRISCO, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Council of the City of Frisco hereby agrees to approve the Resolution to Amend the Consolidated Plan, 2015 – 2019, Citizen Participation Plan, to include the new requirements of the Assessment of Fair Housing.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
