Subject: Consider and Act Upon Approval of a Purchase Order to Securadyne Systems for the Purchase of Traffic Monitoring Cameras during FY 2017

Action Requested: City Council approval of a purchase order to Securadyne Systems for the purchase of traffic monitoring cameras during FY 2017 in the estimated amount of \$53,880.

Background Information: The City of Frisco has an Interlocal Agreement with the State of Texas Department of Information Resources ("DIR") for the purpose of purchasing selected items. Securadyne Systems can provide the City's traffic monitoring cameras through DIR Contract DIR-SDD-2210. This is an Anixter DIR contract with Securadyne listed as an authorized reseller. This will provide for traffic monitoring equipment at new traffic signals, as well as replacement of legacy equipment on existing traffic signals. Total estimated cost for FY 2017 is \$53,880.
