Subject: Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Prosper for GIS Services

The City of Frisco entered into an interlocal agreement with the Town of Prosper (Prosper) during FY 2004 which allowed City of Frisco to provide GIS services to Prosper for a period ending September 30, 2004. Beginning in FY 2005 and continuing through FY 2016 there was a continuation of these services. In FY 2016, the City provided services and received compensation in the amount of \$54,100 for these services. Attached is the proposed interlocal agreement for FY 2017 with the Town of Prosper to continue these services, in the estimated compensated amount of \$55,182.

Below you will find the benefits that both Frisco and Prosper will achieve by continuing this effort.

Benefits for Frisco

1. Receive revenue exceeding expenses.
2. Increase staff at no direct cost.
3. Open the door for other external support opportunities, which could benefit other regional partners.
4. Facilitate regional planning.

Benefits to Prosper

1. Leverage off our highly skilled GIS staff.
2. Utilize our data conversion contract.
3. Obtain GIS services at substantial savings.
4. Provide the powerful resources of GIS, during the Town's early growth.
