**Agenda Caption:** An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Frisco, Texas, designating four (4) election precincts for the February 18, 2017 Special Election to be held in the City of Frisco, Collin and Denton Counties, Texas, as ordered by the City Council; authorizing all necessary actions relating thereto; and providing a savings/repealing clause, severability clause and an effective date.

**Action Requested:** Approve an Ordinance designating new polling locations and reassigning county precincts to the locations.

**Background Information:** The City of Frisco will be holding a Special Election to Fill a Vacancy at a time other than a uniform election date. In light of probable low voter turnout and cost considerations, Council has directed staff to reduce the usual eight (8) polling locations to four (4). This requires reassigning county precincts that were previously assigned to locations that will not be used, to these four (4) polling locations.

Additionally, the City's boundary has changed due to annexations in Denton County and Collin County has split an overly populated precinct to create a new precinct. These new areas will need to be assigned to a polling location.

**Alternatives:** Texas Election Code mandates designating precincts and polling locations when changes are made.
