I want to congratulate you on your success in bringing the 2011 NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision Game to Frisco. The City of Frisco is an excellent fit for such an event and I feel confident that it will be a great benefit to the local economy. As required by the Events Trust Fund statute, our analysis of the increase in tax revenue associated with the event has been completed. We estimate that the state will realize an incremental increase in tax revenue under the Events Trust Fund statute of \$289,367 from Frisco hosting this event and this amount, if matched by \$46,299 in contributions by the City of Frisco, will result in a total contribution of \$335,666 to the trust fund established for this event.
